HEALTH</p> <p>Men live 5 years shorter; triple the suicide rates of women.</p> <p>Read More</p>	 <p>3. BOYS</p> <p>Child labor and hazardous work, child soldiers, extortion, and undernutrition.</p> <p>Read More</p>	 <p>4. FALSE ALLEGATIONS</p> <p>False allegations harm both the innocent accused and real victims.</p> <p>Read More</p>
 <p>5. VICTIMS OF VIOLENCE</p> <p>Men, especially boys, face higher homicide and wartime death rates.</p> <p>Read More</p>	 <p>6. PARENTING</p> <p>Men face court biases, harsher treatment, and undue child support burdens.</p> <p>Read More</p>	 <p>7. CRIMINAL SYSTEM</p> <p>Men receive harsher treatment at every step of the criminal-legal process.</p> <p>Read More</p>	 <p>8. PARTNER ABUSE</p> <p>Men face equal domestic violence, more online harassment, but fewer services.</p> <p>Read More</p>
 <p>9. HOMELESSNESS</p> <p>76% of homeless persons are men.</p> <p>Read More</p>	 <p>10. WORKPLACE</p> <p>Men face 15 times workplace deaths, nearly double the injuries of women.</p> <p>Read More</p>	 <p>11. REPRODUCTIVE</p> <p>Women's choice: have it, abort it, or adopt it; men: no choice.</p> <p>Read More</p>	 <p>12. MEDIA</p> <p>Men: 69% unfavorable, 12% favorable, and 19% neutral or balanced.</p> <p>Read More</p>
